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

TEVTA Overview

Technical Education & Vocational Training Authority (TEVTA) is a Special Institution established in 1999 under the Industries Department, Govt. of the Punjab; currently being governed through TEVTA ACT 2010 for provision of Technical Education & Vocational Training in Punjab.

In order to extent complete autonomy for reorganization and effective management, the policy making task had been entrusted to the P-TEVTA Board. TEVTA Board consisting of eminent professionals, from public and private sector, representatives from leading industries, universities etc. Board has 15 members, including 3 females and 3 Ex-officio members. The Chairperson of the board is the Chief Executive Officer, while the Chief Operating Officer serves as the board's secretary. Major 6 functional departments are headed by concerned Director General.

TEVTA is divided into 3 geographical regions, namely Centre, North, and South, each led by a Regional Director under Director General Operation-I. Additionally, there are 20 districts under TEVTA's jurisdiction, with each district being headed by a District Director under Director General Operation-II.

TEVTA is the Largest Skill Provider in Punjab offering 150+ courses ranging from 03 Months to 04 Years in 18 Sectors.



Skills Summer Camp

(SED, HED & TEVTA)

The initiative aims to instill a skill-oriented mindset among the youth. By emphasizing the value of vocational education, the camps encourage students to view technical skills as equally important as academic qualifications. This shift in mindset not only benefits individual career prospects but also helps bridge the gap between skilled workforce demand and supply in the region.

Keeping this in view, First ever tripartite agreement between ICI&SDD (TEVTA) School Education Department (SED) and the Higher Education Department (HED) was signed on 15th May 2023. Under this MoU, free of cost skill based training programs of 3 months duration were introduced w.e.f. 01.06.2023 for the students of public schools and colleges during summer vacations. Now ICI&SDD (TEVTA) is successfully imparting skills in 14 trades at 25 selected TEVTA institutes (All Divisional Headquarters and Sialkot City). Furthermore Rasul Technology University MBDin and Mir Chakar Rind Technology University are also imparting Skills based Training during summer vacations. ICI&SDD (TEVTA) in collaboration with all the stakeholders has taken special measures in these programs through an effective monitoring mechanism for maintaining interest/ inclination of the students towards the skills. Vocational Training for Prisoners

Empowering Lives & Building Skills

Since 2015, the Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority (TEVTA) has been collaborating with the Home Department to impart vocational training to prisoners in 15 locations (jails) across Punjab. This ambitious initiative has successfully trained approximately 20,000 prisoners in 16 different trades during its first phase.

Under the visionary leadership of Chief Minister Punjab, Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi, the initiative is now expanding further. A momentous agreement was recently signed between the Department of Prisons Punjab and TEVTA Punjab at the Chief Minister Secretariat. The signing ceremony was graced by esteemed personalities, including Chairman P&D, Mr. Ali Sarfraz Malik, Additional Chief Secretary Home, Mr. Shakeel Ahmed Mian, Secretary Industries Punjab, Mr. Ehsan Bhutta, and Additional Secretary prisoners, Mr. Syed Hasan Raza.

Inspector General Prisons Punjab, Mian Farooq Nazir, signed the agreement on behalf of the Department of Jails Punjab, while Secretary TEVTA Punjab, Mr. Ahmad Khawar Shahzad, represented TEVTA Punjab.

Expanding Opportunities

With this agreement, vocational training centers will be established in 10 more jails across Punjab, including various District Jails. The objective is to provide skillful training and economic empowerment to prisoners, fostering their reintegration into society and reducing recidivism rates.

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Training of other Departments (PMBMC, PTS, TD AJK)



An innovative approach has been implemented to optimize the resources of staff training colleges. These colleges are now catering to the training needs of attached departments, of ICI & SDD, as well as other government departments. Customized training programs have been designed to meet the specific requirements of each department, ensuring their relevance and effectiveness. To deliver high-quality training, qualified and experienced trainers have been engaged. The focus is on providing valuable training sessions that align with the needs of the respective departments. Currently, plans are in place to conduct training for the Punjab Model Bazaars Management Company (PMBMC) in August. The training will cover essential topics to enhance their capabilities and efficiency. Furthermore, in response to a request from the Tourism, Archaeology, and Museums Department, two batches of the Punjab Tourism Squad (PTS) have successfully completed their training at the Staff Training College Murree. The training was conducted in collaboration with Rescue 1122, the Army, and professional trainers. It encompassed diverse areas such as conflict resolution, motivation, green tourism, responsible and eco-friendly tourism, sports, salami, parade, physical fitness, and hiking. These skills are crucial for helping tourists during challenging situations like land sliding, rainfall, or snow. Moreover, the Tourism Department of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (TD AJK) has also approached ICI&SDD (TEVTA) to organize training for their staff. The groundwork for this initiative has already commenced.




Change in Capacity Building Mechanism for TEVTA Staff



In continuation of Capacity Building Mechanism for TEVTA Staff One Week Skill Up gradation Training has been inaugurated. Under this training instead of class room training (limited to two days) 3-4 days industrial training on modern machinery is being imparted to Teachers/Head teachers and on successful assessment by Industrialists, they will then impart Machine based practical training to students.

To equip the faculty with ever changing industry requirement, special emphasis has now been given to introduce a new mechanism for having collaboration with the industry to conduct trainings on the industrial floors for the faculty. So far 90 TEVTA teachers have got training with new methodology.



Preservation & Promotion of Historical Buildings



The preservation of historical buildings is of paramount importance as it serves multiple crucial purposes, such as safeguarding cultural heritage, promoting education and tourism, and nurturing a sense of community pride and identity. Recognizing the significance of conserving cultural identity, special efforts are being made to protect buildings with rich historical backgrounds. Constructed in 1909 by Sir Shadi Lal, a distinguished personality who served as the Chief Justice of Lahore High Court from 1920 to 1934 and was also a member of the Judicial Committee, Privy Council London from 1934 to 1938, this heritage building showcases a unique blend of Mughal, British (Colonial), and Sikh architectural elements.

Taking responsibility for preserving this cultural gem, ICI & SDD (TEVTA) has joined hands with the Archeology Department & Building Department to develop a comprehensive plan.

In the first phase, the building has been architecturally illuminated, enhancing its visual appeal and historical significance. Further preservation efforts are already underway, and additional measures will be implemented in the near future.






Painting Competition




