

LANDSCAPE OF TEVTA PUNJAB


Technical Education & Vocational Training Authority (TEVTA) is a Special Institution established in 1999 under the Industries Department, Govt. of the Punjab; currently being governed through TEVTA ACT 2010 for provision of Technical Education & Vocational Training in Punjab.

In order to extent complete autonomy for reorganization and effective management, the policy making task had been entrusted to the P-TEVTA Board of management. TEVTA Board consisting of eminent professionals, from public and private sector, representatives from leading industries, universities etc. Board has 15 members, including 3 females and 3 Ex-officio members. The Chairperson of the board is the Chief Executive Officer, while the Chief Operating Officer serves as the board's secretary. Major six functional departments are headed by concerned Director General.

TEVTA is divided into 3 geographical regions, namely Centre, North, and South, each led by a Regional Director under Director General Operation-I. Additionally, there are 20 districts under TEVTA's jurisdiction, with each district being headed by a District Director under Director General Operation-II.

TEVTA is the Largest Skill Provider in Punjab offering 150+ courses ranging from 03 Months to 04 Years in 18 Sectors

SUPPLY LINE FOR OVERSEAS EMPLOYMENT

Bureau of Emigration and Overseas Employment (BE&OE) is working as a centralized agency of the Federal Government to control and regulate processing of recruitment demands of the Pakistani manpower through Licensed Overseas Employment Promoters (OEPs) etc. These emigrants all over the world are source of remittances for the homeland. TEVTA is facilitating and promoting overseas employment for the TEVTA pass-outs and gradually

expanded the interaction with relevant institutional stakeholders of overseas employment in Pakistan i.e. M/o OP&HRD, BE&OE, OEC, and OEPs. TEVTA objectives and initiatives regarding foreign placements are purely consistent and supportive to the objectives of these institutional stakeholders. Remittances sent by the Pakistani workers in the last few past years are depicted below:





Similarly, Overseas Employment Corporation (OEC) works for promotion of employment of professionals, highly skilled, skilled, semi-skilled and un-skilled manpower in foreign countries. The Corporation assists the employers in conducting tests and interviews of candidates.

OEC under an MOU has also facilitated TEVTA graduates through provision of special rights for uploading their profiles on OEC's foreign jobs portal. TEVTA & OEC's IT teams are ambitious for integration of the portals of both organizations for data sharing and substantial portion of integration has been completed.


During the last three years overall participation of TEVTA graduates in the emigrants worker processed

through OEPs were 3011 persons representing in 35 countries on 51 classified trades of BE&OE. COVID remained an obstacle in foreign travelling and international job market. These candidates were among the holder of 220 TEVTA courses of different nomenclature and duration ranging from 36 Months to 5 Weeks.


101 candidates were adjusted exactly in their trades. 110 candidates successfully hired at Technician level and 30 as Supervisors. 787 candidates attained emigration as Helper/Labor and 528 availed chance as General Worker.



SUPPLY LINE FOR OVERSEAS EMPLOYMENT




Few other geographic and country wise breakup of TEVTA graduates reflect outflow toward different regions:










There is no tool for development more effective than the empowerment of women.


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
